On Saturday, April 13, 2024, Hunt Branch Library had its longawaited Grand Re-Opening. The Re-Opening was only possible due to the support of the local community and groups like the Fullerton Public Library Foundation that helped saved it. Hunt Branch Library began an extensive restoration that encompassed the floor all the way to the ceiling. During the restoration modern amenities were added like newer eco-friendly restrooms and high-speed internet. With all those upgrades, Hunt Branch Library is not just a library where one can check-out books and attend library programing like family Storytime, Game Days, Crafternoons, and others, but also a multipurpose facility for thought-provoking and informative exhibitions like the award winning "A Class Action" from the Museum of Teaching and Learning (MOTAL) that covers racial segregation in Orange County and other large community events like the recent Día del Niño presented by Arts Orange County on April 27th. The revitalization of Hunt Library began with funding from the State of California requested by Assembly Member Sharon Quirk-Silva and State Senator Josh Newman and administered by the State Library. It was the Foundation which provided the matching funds for two USAC/FCC grants for IT infrastructure as well as matching funding for the State Library Building Forward (Round 1) Library Infrastructure Grant. Beyond that, the Foundation also funded critically needed start-up funds to fulfill the vision of the Library as a rentable community center to perpetuate its existence. The Foundation also funded the branch library with a robust starting collection of materials to borrow and equipment for exciting programming possibilities. The response of the community at the Re-Opening was extremely enthusiastic and we thank the Foundation for being a vital partner returning this branch library to serving the community.
